Today, March 23, 2020, the Parker County Commissioners Court unanimously approved a First Amended Emergency Declaration of Local Disaster Due to Public Health. This declaration was in response to the first verified diagnosis of COVID-19 in Parker County and goes into effect at 6:00 PM on Tuesday, March 24, 2020. This declaration may last up to 30 days in duration, if necessary, and primarily includes restrictions on the operation of certain businesses and gathering places. Rest assured, I have been in continuous communication with Judge Deen and he has been forthcoming with the current situation facing our county.
