

ORDINANCE NO. 2020-05

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE 12.03 "PARKING, STOPPING AND STANDING" OF THE HUDSON OAKS CITY CODE TO ADD A NEW SECTION 12.03.002 ESTABLISHING A TWO HOUR PARKING LIMIT ON DESIGNATED PORTIONS OF OAKEY TRAIL; PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE CUMULATIVE OF ALL ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING A PENALTY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION IN THE OFFICIAL NEWSPAPER; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson Oaks, Texas is a Type A general-law municipality located in Parker County, created in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 6 of the Local Government Code and operating pursuant to the enabling legislation of the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, Article 12.03 of the Hudson Oaks Code of Ordinances currently only addresses parking in areas designated for persons with disabilities; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to amend Article 12.03 by adding a new Section 12.03.002 to include two-hour parking regulations, by identifying and designating parking restrictions for on street parking along Oakey Trail, from Hudson Oaks Drive to Midway Lane.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HUDSON OAKS, TEXAS:

SECTION 1.

That Article 12.03 "Parking, Stopping and Standing" of the Hudson Oaks City Code is hereby amended to add a new Section 12.03.002 to read as follows:

ARTICLE 12.03 PARKING, STOPPING AND STANDING

...

Sec. 12.03.002 Oakey Corridor- Two-hour limited parking between 8:00 am and 6:00 pm

- (a) "Vehicle" – In accordance to Texas Transportation Code, Section 502.001, means a device in or by which a person or property is or may be transported or drawn on a public highway, other than a device used exclusively on stationary rails or tracks.
- (b) "Oakey Corridor" - shall be designated as that portion of the public roadway known as Oakey Trail, with diagonal parking, located from Hudson Oaks Drive to Midway Lane.
- (c) When signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall park a vehicle for a period longer than two (2) hours between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m., in any parking

space or designated area, along the Oakey Corridor on any day of the week, except Sundays, or during special events as designated by the City Council.

- (d) Vehicles may not re-park along the Oakey Corridor, per calendar day. It shall be a violation for any person to park a vehicle in excess of two hours in any given parking space on the Oakey Corridor.
- (e) Parking Within Lines - The City shall place lines or marks on the street to designate the diagonal parking spaces. Each vehicle shall park within the lines or markings so established. It shall be unlawful to park any vehicle across any such line or mark or to park the vehicle in a way that the same shall not be within the area so designated by the line or mark.
- (f) The provisions of this section shall not relieve any person from the duty to observe other and more restrictive provisions of this article or the State Transportation Code prohibiting or limiting the stopping, standing or parking of vehicles in specified places.
- (g) Any person who violates this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine of \$25.00. Each occurrence of parking in violation of this section shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 2.

This Ordinance shall be cumulative of all provisions of ordinances and of the Hudson Oaks City Code, as amended, except when the provisions of this Ordinance are in direct conflict with the provisions of such ordinances and such code, in which event the conflicting provisions of such ordinances and such code are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3.

It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that the sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, and phrases of this Ordinance are severable, and if any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, and phrases of this Ordinance, since the same would have been enacted by the City Council without the incorporation in this Ordinance of any such unconstitutional section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase.

SECTION 4.

Any person, firm or corporation who violates, disobeys, omits, neglects or refuses to comply with or who resists the enforcement of any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be fined in accordance with the general penalty for violations of the City Code set forth in Section

1.01.009 for each offense. Each day that a violation is permitted to exist shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 5.

The City Secretary of the City of Hudson Oaks is hereby directed to publish in the official newspaper of the City of Hudson Oaks, the caption, penalty clause, and effective date clause of this ordinance as authorized by Section 52.011 of the Local Government Code.


SECTION 6.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication, and it is so ordained.


