

ORDINANCE NO. 2020-06

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HUDSON OAKS, TEXAS REPEALING SECTION 3.14.007 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES; PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE CUMULATIVE OF ALL ORDINANCES; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson Oaks is a type A general law municipality located in Parker County, created in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 6 of the Local Government Code and operating pursuant to the enabling legislation of the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to repeal Section 3.14.007 of the Code of Ordinances to remove the obsolete reference to the adoption of the 2003 Uniform Sign Code.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HUDSON OAKS, TEXAS:

SECTION 1.

That Section 3.14.007 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Hudson Oaks be and is hereby repealed in its entirety. The remainder of Article 3.14 "Sign Regulations" remains in full force and effect.

**SECTION 2.
PROVISIONS CUMULATIVE**

This ordinance shall be cumulative of all provisions of ordinances and the Code of Ordinances of the City of Hudson Oaks, Texas, as amended, except where the provisions of this ordinance are in direct conflict with the provisions of such ordinances, in which event the conflicting provisions of such ordinances are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 3.
PROVISIONS SEVERABLE**

It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that the phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, and sections of this ordinance are severable, and if any phrase, clause, sentence paragraph or section of this ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections of this ordinance, since the same would have been enacted by the Board of Commissioners without the incorporation in this ordinance of any such unconstitutional phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section.

**SECTION 4.
EFFECTIVE DATE**

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, and it is so ordained.


