HOW TO RECYCLING

When you recycle at home, you can play an important role in taking care of the earth, but doing it correctly is the key to preventing materials from ending up in our lakes and landfills. Follow these easy steps to kickstart your recycling journey.

(1) Know What To Throw: Make sure you're putting the right materials in your recycling container.

(2) Empty, Clean, Dry: Keep all your recyclables free of food and liquid. It takes just one dirty item to contaminate an entire truckload of recyclables.

(3) Don't Bag It: Never bag or bundle your recyclables. The items need to be placed loose inside your bin.

What can you recycle?

1. Paper
2. Cardboard (no pizza boxes)
3. Plastic
4. Aluminum/Metal
5. Glass
