# HUDSON OAKS, TEXAS WATER & WASTEWATER RATE STUDY



#### **BACKGROUND**

1 – Average Water Bill is 9,000 Gallons

2 – Average Wastewater Bill is 6,000 Gallons

- Rate review initiated due to upcoming capital investment requirements and changes in the City's wholesale water and wastewater providers
- Significant time has elapsed since prior water and wastewater rate adjustments
- Average annual increase in CPI for Water, Sewer, and Trash providers is approximately 4.38%

- Transfers to Water Fund in FY 2024 to Minimize Rate Increases

- Maintaining a 1.10x Debt Service Coverage Determined the Rate Increase Amounts

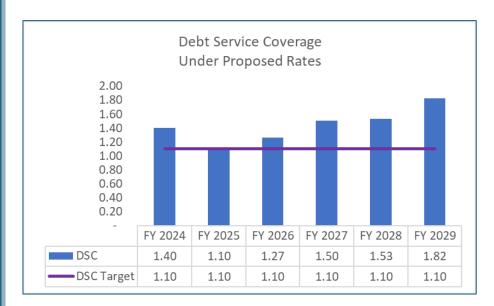

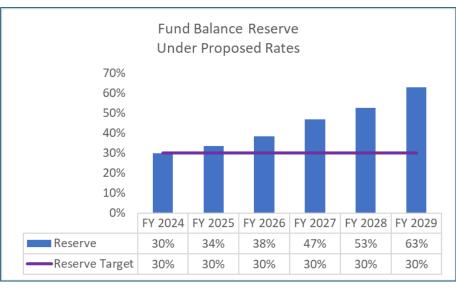
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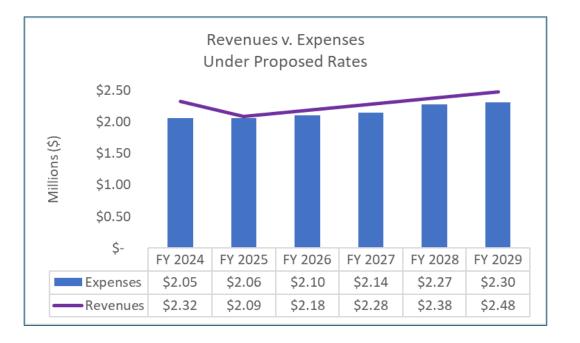

Dyegard in FY 2024



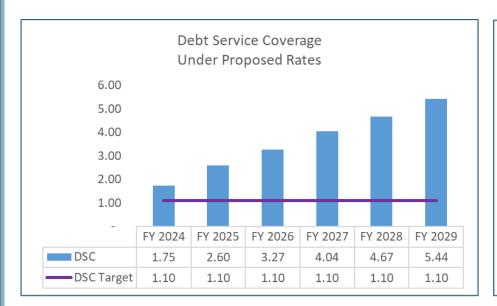


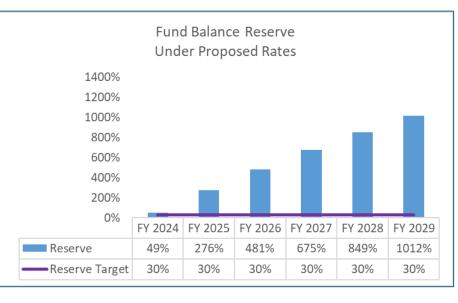


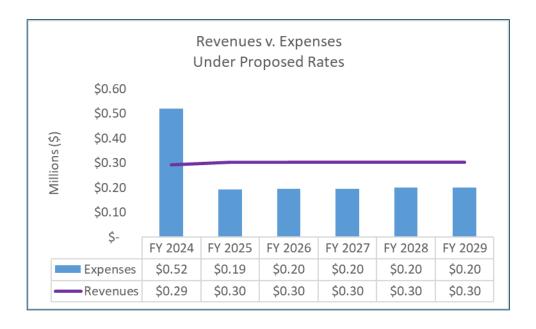

Drop In Expenses Due to One-Time Transfer to Water in FY 2024



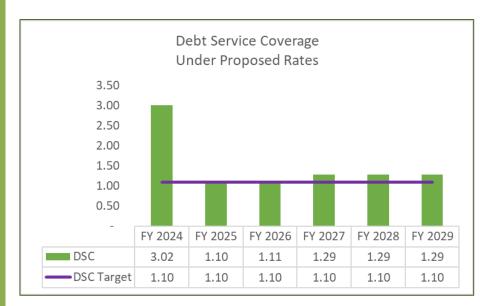


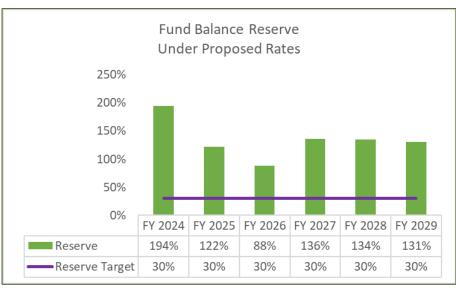


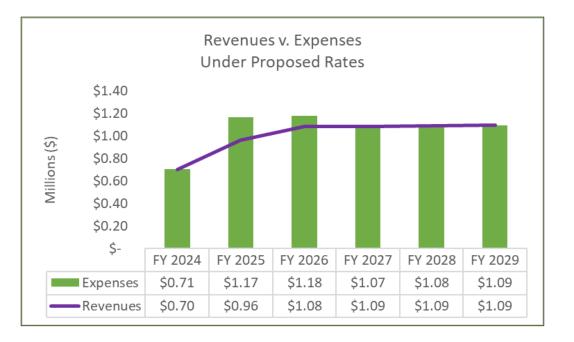

3/4" Residential – 9,000 Gallons Water & 6,000 Gallons Wastewater

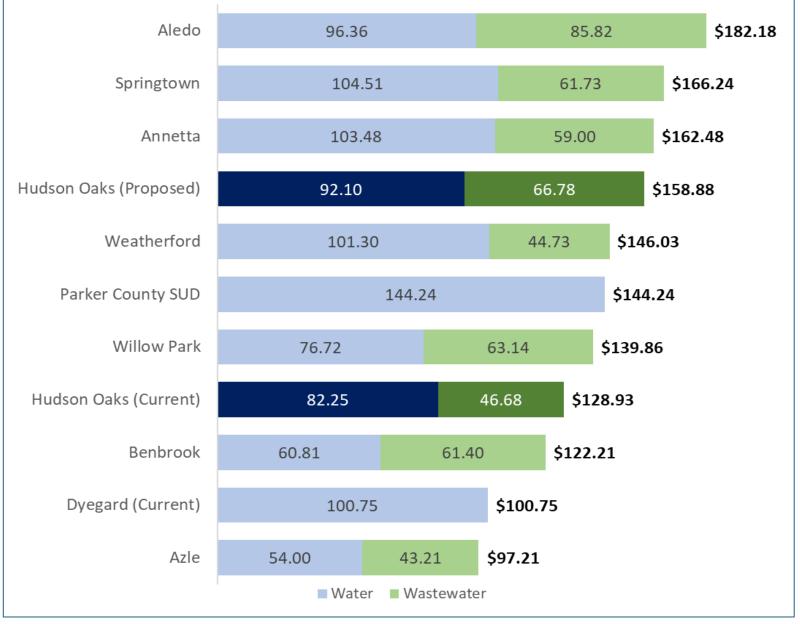

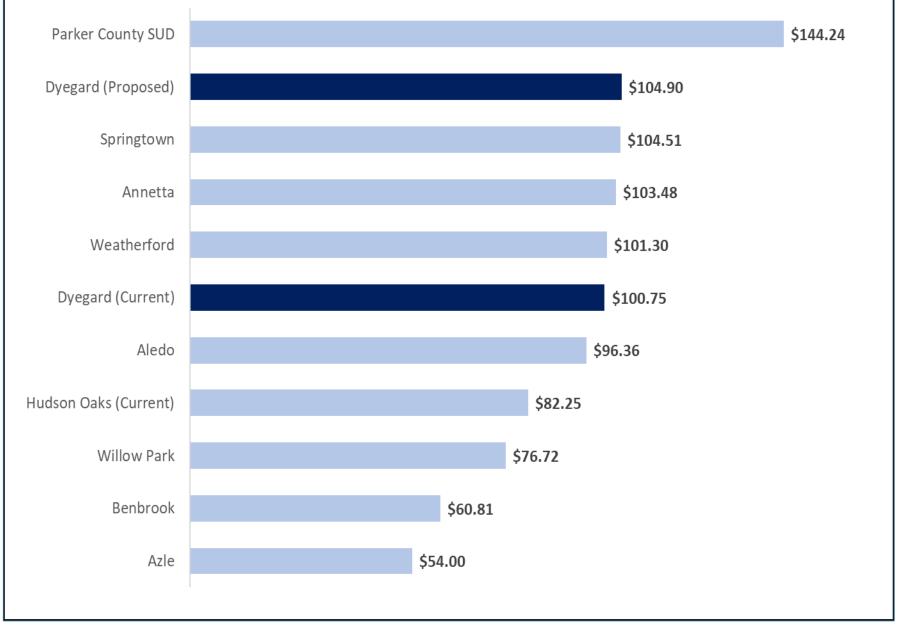

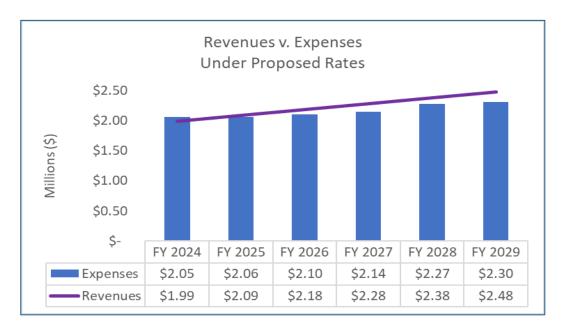

Drop In Revenues Due to One-Time Transfer from Wastewater in FY 2024

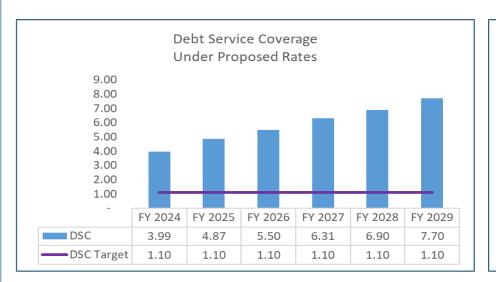


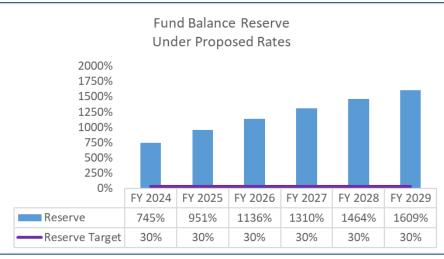


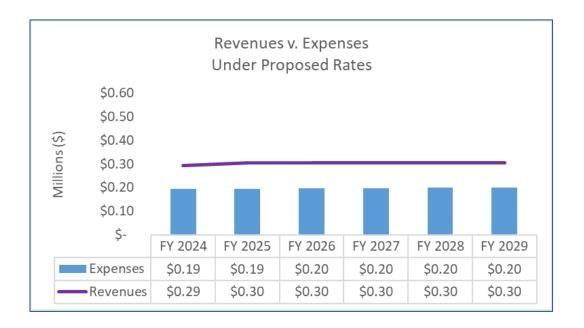
